



THE EASTER LAMB

The Paschal Lamb symbolizes the Risen Lord, Jesus Christ -

The Lamb of God - the Christian symbol of the Passover

Sacrifice of Jesus from death to life.

It is to be placed on the front window or storm door of the home,

Witnessing to who and what we believe as Christians:

“We are an Easter people, and Alleluia is our song.”

The symbol of the lamb remains in a prominent place from:

Easter Sunday, April 12, 2020 until the Easter Season

is completed - 50 days later - on Pentecost, May 31, 2020.

It is taken down on this day.

THE EASTER LAMB



The Paschal Lamb symbolizes the Risen Lord, Jesus Christ – The Lamb of God – the Christian symbol of the Passover Sacrifice of Jesus from death to life.
